- 1. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Venetian Rewards card to participate.
- 2. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of levels 4, 8, 11, and then every four levels.
- 3. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
- 4. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
- 5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- 6. \$1,600 Buy-In starts with 40,000 in chips. Each level is thirty (30) minutes.
- 7. \$175 of the \$1,600 Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). Prize pool consists of \$1,425 of every \$1,600 Buy In.
- 8. Players receive \$500 Bounty for each player they eliminate from the tournament. Once we reach the money (posted payouts) players receive a \$1,000 Bounty for each player they eliminate from the tournament. If two or more players eliminate another player from the tournament with the exact same hand, the Bounty will be split equally amongst all winning hands. The player who wins the event does not get to keep their own bounty, as this remains part of the prize pool.
- 9. Registration and Re-Entry is allowed for eleven (11) levels and through the break.
- 10. Ante will come from the Big Blind Only. The Big Blind is posted before the Ante.
- 11. A Prize Pool of \$500,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room. The total prize pool consists of the actual prize money plus the total amount of \$500 and \$1,000 Bounties that are awarded.
- 12. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.

13. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament

14. This event pays 12.5% of the field.

- 15. Near the money bubble, at Tournament Directors Discretion, players will have twenty (20) seconds pre-flop and thirty (30) seconds post-flop to act on their hand through the use of a countdown clock. Based on field size, players will receive the following time-extension chips, each worth a 30-second addition to a player's action: Less than 46 players: 5-time extension chips.
 - 46-72 players: 3-time extension chips + 3 at 27 players remaining.
 - 73-99 players: 4-time extension chips + 3 at 27 players remaining.
 - 100 + players: 5-time extension chips + 3 at 27 players remaining.

In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time-extension chips, the player's countdown clock will automatically extend an additional thirty (30) seconds. Collection of time-extension chips will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's countdown clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, he/she will be (a) forced to check, if there is no bet pending or (b) fold, if facing a bet or raise. Shot clocks will be removed at the Final Table.
